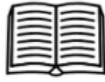

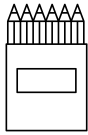

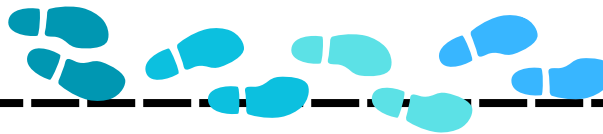


Have you ever built something and realized a piece was missing? It can feel frustrating because things don't feel finished. God made the world good and whole. People were close to God, and everything worked the way it should. But sin came into the world. Sin is choosing our own way instead of God's way. Sin broke our friendship with God and brought sadness, pain, and hurt into the world.

God didn't leave things broken. He sent Jesus to help us. Jesus never sinned. He died on the cross to take the punishment for our sins, and three days later He came back to life.

That's why we celebrate Easter. Jesus is alive! When we believe in Him and ask for forgiveness, God makes us clean and close to Him again. Jesus is the missing piece that makes everything whole.

Habit Builder



Each day, take a quiet moment to thank Jesus for making your life whole. You can do this in the morning, at night, or anytime during the day.

You might pray like this:

"Thank You, Jesus, for loving me. Thank You for dying on the cross for my sins and for coming back to life. Thank You for making me close to God. Help me follow You and make good choices today."

You can also think of one good thing you noticed that day, like a kind word, a flower, or a hug. When you do, remember that Jesus is alive and with you.
